EVENT INTRODUCTION

The first ever European Universities Winter Sports Championships will be held in Val di Zoldo, Italy from December 18-21, 2023. Organized by CUS Venezia, in close collaboration with FederCUSI, Ca' Foscari University of Venice, and the luav University of Venice, the event will offer university sport competition in Alpine Skiing and Snowboarding, in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere. Snow Volleyball will also be offered as a demonstrative sport. The Championships are expected to attract athletes aged 17-30, officials, organizational staff, and volunteers, in the beautiful mountain setting of the Dolomites.

LOCATION

Val di Zoldo is a municipality in the Province of Belluno in the Italian region Veneto, located in the heart of the Unesco Dolomites. Geographically, it lies in the northeastern part of Italy, close to the border of Austria and Slovenia. The mountains here offer the chance to venture into the spaces between the magnificent rocks close by, or explore huge, clear spaces, with lofty peaks in the distance, able to convey a sense of infinity and freedom, capable of instilling a deep breath.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE



CUS Venezia A.S.D., affiliated to FederCUSI, has been carrying out since 1949 a continuous sporting activity ranging from motor and recreational activity to real agonism. The CUS involves a very large number of people (about 3,000 per year) through different forms of aggregation which, for their continuous development, have made the Company acquire an absolutely relevant weight and incidence in the Veneto sports environment, thus consolidating over the years a know-how and an organisational capacity that place us as a reliable organisation and an important point of reference both for local bodies, whom relationships of effective collaboration are underway, both for the official sports bodies (CONI and Sports Federations).

CUS Venezia A.S.D. has a long and consolidated experience in organising major events, directly or in collaboration with Federations and Sports Associations.

At the organisational level we have the following experience:

- National University Winter Championships in 1993, 2018 and 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023;
- National Spring University Championships in 1982 in Venice and in 2007 in Jesolo (VE);
- University World Handball Championships in 2008 in Jesolo;
- The International Athletics Meetings in the years from 1978 to 1983 with the presence of the greatest national and world athletes including Mennea, Dorio, Simeoni;

We also cooperated:

- With the FIPAV, to the organisation of the 1978 Volleyball World Championships;
- With Men's and Women's Volleyball League at the finals of the Italian Beach Volleyball Championships in 2001 and 2002 and at the men's Coppa Italia finals in 1992 and women's in 2002;
- With Venicemarathon, from 1986 to today, we have supported the organisation of all the editions of the marathon.

CO ORGANIZERS



The Italian Federation of University Sports (FederCUSI), formerly the Italian University Sports Centre (CUSI) is a National Sports Federation recognised by CONI to which the State has entrusted the task of taking care of the practice, dissemination and enhancement of physical education and sports activity for Italian university students.

To this end, a University Sports Centre (CUS) is established at each Italian city, with management and administrative autonomy, which deals with the management of the sports facilities owned by the universities, organising in them, or at other facilities, courses, championships and various activities aimed at the pursuit of the institutional purposes of the institution. The CUS is responsible for its work to a Committee for Sport, set up at each university, which includes two representatives of the students, two representatives of FederCUSI, the Administrative Director of the university and the Rector who chairs the body.

The FederCUSI is responsible for taking care of the national activity, the National University Championships (CNU) in the various disciplines, and the international one, setting up in particular, with the help of the competent Sports Federations, the representatives participating in the University World Championships and the Universides, an event similar to the Olympics reserved for university athletes.

The Italian Federation of University Sports is a member-founder of FISU (Féderation Internationale du Sport Universitaire), the body that brings together all the National Associations of University Sports in the world.

As such, FederCUSI participates in almost all the events organised by the Federation both in the strictly sporting field (Universiade, University World Championships) and in the cultural field, through participation in the conferences promoted by CESU, the body that in FISU is responsible for drawing the lines, addresses and objectives of university sport in the world.

The FederCUSI also has to its credit the organisation of 4 summer Universiades and 5 winter editions, as well as the organisation of numerous University World Championships in the various disciplines.

HOW TO GET TO VAL DI ZOLDO

- If you arrive at Venice "Marco Polo" international airport: you will be welcome by one of our staff who will accompany you from the arrivals to the organized pick up point.
- If you arrive by your own transport:

the appointment is at the Sala Fusine of the Municipality of Val di Zoldo between 10:00 a.m. and 09:00 p.m. of December 17th.

HOW TO GET TO THE TRACK

- From each hotel on the 18th to the 21st there will be departures for the race venues.


The first transfer leaves from 7.30am with a specific time, which will be indicated in each individual hotel.

- The shuttles are arranged by OC and the hotels, however as the distances are very short we recommend using private transport to be more independent.

The car park at Piazza Rodolfo Balestra is very spacious.

- OC transport will also be available for the opening ceremony.
- OC vehicles will be present 1 for each hotel, always in Piazza Rodolfo Balestra.

RENTAL AND OTHER INFORMATION

SKI PASS

Ski passes purchased for €90.00 for the days from 18 to 21 December are nominative and non-transferable and are valid for the entire SKICIVETTA area.

In case of loss of the ski pass, it can be restored at the Funivie Val di Zoldo office in Piazza Rodolfo Balestra

The cost of a single day ski pass is provided at the special cost of **59.00** euros. It must be purchased at the above office.

The cost of a single return trip on the cable car that takes you to Pian del Crep from Piazza Rodolfo Balestra can be purchased at a cost of **12.00** euros.

The opening hours of the facilities are as follows: from 08.30 a.m. at 04:30 p.m. and only for Thursday 21 December also from 07.30 p.m. to 11.00 p.m. The Organizing Committee will determine early openings for any competition needs that will be communicated.

SKI STORAGE

At the ski rental and storage room in Piazza Rodolfo Balestra it is possible to rent ski and snowboard equipment and rent a lot for the ski storage room. For all participants in the event at the Val di Zoldo ski center of the Balestra family it is possible to:

- Rent equipment with a 20% discount please contact the ski center directly on 17 and 18 December if possible at these references https://www.livecivetta.it/centro-sci/
- Or it is possible to rent a locker for storing skis and personal equipment at a cost of €3.00 per day or at the special total price of €10.00 from 18 to 21 December. Always contact https://www.livecivetta.it/centro-sci/

INSURANCE

In case of accident while on lifts or slopes, all skiers holding a valid Val di Zoldo's ski-pass are guaranteed emergency rescue and medical assistance.

This includes:

- immediate rescue by dedicated emergency team
- on-site medical evaluation
- transportation to the nearest hospital by ambulance or helicopter
- · emergency medical treatment of the injury
- 2) All skiers will be responsible for any damages or injuries caused to third parties.

In Italy since 2022 this insurance is mandatory for all skiers.

Skiers may use their own insurance if they have it, or purchase a temporary insurance for the ski-pass duration at 3 euros per day.

MEDICAL SERVICE

The medical service of the FIS competition regulations is provided at the race venues, a doctor with emergency protocol will be present for each race site.

In each hotel, a doctor dedicated to any health problems is available 24 hours a day and you can contact them by referring to the volunteers present in each hotel as an information point.
