

EVENT INTRODUCTION

The first ever European Universities Winter Sports Championships will be held in Val di Zoldo, Italy from December 18-21, 2023. Organized by CUS Venezia, in close collaboration with FederCUSI, Ca' Foscari University of Venice, and the luav University of Venice, the event will offer university sport competition in Alpine Skiing and Snowboarding, in a friendly and relaxed atmosphere. Snow Volleyball will also be offered as a demonstrative sport.

The Championships are expected to attract athletes aged 17-30, officials, organizational staff, and volunteers, in the beautiful mountain setting of the Dolomites.

LOCATION



We will have a maximum of 12 matches per day with a daily start on the first two days 8:30 AM and the final day 9:30 AM. The last game preview at 15:00. Competition will be held following the EUSA document "Rules and Regulations for the European Universities Championship 2023".

Training program

Training field will not be available while the tournament is running.

1 (one) men's tournament, maximum of 6 teams,

1 (one) women's tournament, maximum of 6 teams.

MEDICAL AND SECURITY SERVICES

EUSA - regulated medical care and an ambulance will be provided.

Security Services will be provided in all the venues, to for entrance control and to assure all participants'safety.

International regulations

The organization of the EUC Winter Sports shall be mainly based on the most recent Technical Regulations of the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB) and the European Volleyball Confederation (CEV).

Program

The competitions consist of three days. The General Technical Meeting, where the presence of each Head of Delegation is obligatory, will be held one day prior to the start of the competition.

Delegation

The delegation will consist of 4 athletes and maximum of 2 officials. The Head of Delegation must be appointed.

Referees

OC shall provide referees.

The delegation may, at its own cost, include a referee with at least the highest national license, but preferably with an International (FIVB) qualification; a relevant license of the International/National Volleyball Federation must be submitted within the quantitative entry deadline. Accommodation and food for the referee must be provided by the OC without charging the participation fee; no refereeing fee is provided.

OC shall provide 2 sets of polo shirts and 1 white sun protection hat per referee.

Protest procedure

Head of Delegation may protest in written on behalf of their athletes or team. Protest must be accompanied by a deposit of 200 EUR (refundable if justified) and submitted to the EUSA representative, as follows:

- within 20 min after match on match issues;
- within 1 hour after published official daily sport results and statistics for the published issues,
- whenever during the EUC on non technical issues.

Protest on referee or match official decision is not permitted.

INSURANCE

In case of accident while on lifts or slopes, all skiers holding a valid Val di Zoldo's ski-pass are guaranteed emergency rescue and medical assistance.

This includes:

- · immediate rescue by dedicated emergency team
- on-site medical evaluation
- transportation to the nearest hospital by ambulance or helicopter
- emergency medical treatment of the injury
- 2) All skiers will be responsible for any damages or injuries caused to third parties.

In Italy since 2022 this insurance is mandatory for all skiers. Skiers may use their own insurance if they have it, or purchase a temporary insurance for the ski-pass duration at 3 euros per day.
